How Can the US Leadership Be So Blind?

I am sure that we have made many mistakes in judgment as a nation before, but the one we are making regarding the situation in Honduras is nothing short of heavy-handed politics and a disgrace to our position in the world as a dominant power. In the event that you do not know the truth behind all the rhetoric regarding the presidential changes, please allow me to inform you of the things I know.

The former president ran on a platform of change to benefit the common man of Honduras. Initially, he was on target with his promises and provided assistance to the working class by raising the wage base. However, at some point, under the influence of Chavez of Venezuela, he decided that their constitutional one-term presidency was not enough to give him the power that he desired. To make this possible and under the advisement of Chavez tactics, he decided to hold a special issue vote. The Supreme Court ruled that this was unconstitutional and inappropriate for him to do. He determined to do it anyway, against the ruling constitution. When this occurred, the congress, under the direction of the Supreme Court, removed him from office. By this time he was no longer supported by over 95% of the population.

The removal of him by force was ruled a coup by the world. However, this came initially from the Venezuelan Press. He is now barred from the country until changes are made. They do not want a socialist president in Honduras. US leadership under Sec. of State Clinton, has made wrong and far reaching demands which will have devastating effects on the people of Honduras as well as future relationship with the US.

In the past, Honduras has proven to be one of our greatest Central American supporters. It is time that we examine the far leftist socialistic approach for a united Americas.

Berean Trained 2 Lead

One of the best sites that I am aware of to fully train the laity of local churches, is soon to be available online at <<bt2l.org>> Our newest board member, Pastor Joe Brewer, is the owner of this site which is available as a partner to Global Networks. There is currently a world-wide need for material that will assist with the training of new church members. After a thorough examination we are also finding that many long time Christians are somewhat deficient in their knowledge of the Bible and its application to daily life, including how they are to follow the calling or giftedness which comes from Father God.

Our **CHURCH DEVELOPMENT DIVISION** will be the area where we can readily adapt this material. We are working toward providing the material in Spanish to assist with the work in Honduras.

We are also talking with Dr. Tim Miller, author of discipleship materials that have been translated in several African dialects. He, also, is interested in getting his material translated and placed in the hands of those needing training.

Inversiones Agro-Industriales de Honduras

This is one of the most far reaching corporations passed by the Honduras government and it has now been donated to Global Networks in my name. It will be in my name since it is a for-profit corporation and should not be mixed with the business of Global. I have no clue what this means, but wait excitedly until the Father reveals it to us.

Two Potentially Large Donations

Without a doubt, I realize I should never second guess God and the mysterious ways He does His work. If He chose to use me, He can use anything or anyone.

We have recently become participants in two significant endeavors that could potentially offer a very significant assistance to the work of Global Networks. Because on the on-going nature of these activities, I will wait until we have the full revelation of what God is doing with these wonderful possibilities.

If the larger of these two possibilities comes about, I will be calling for a full meeting of the Global Board of Directors and Advisors. This will be in Nashville and Global will cover the entire expense of this three day meeting. **In the meantime, please pray** that these things will come about. It will mean an entirely new day for Global Networks and the work God has blessed us to participate in with Him.
