The team was amazed at the offer and the Day Care facility turned out to be even more than was expected. Everyone came away with very positive suggestions that we immediately begin the processes making way for full operation of this wonderful work. Combined with the fact that we now have five or six churches in the area of Cofradia and the very positive reception given of those responsible from the governmental standpoint, we believe this will be a foundational work which will have far reaching affect on the overall work of Global Networks in Honduras.

The team was greatly impressed that the government will provide the facility with a hands-off contract. This means that Global can operate the facility as we so choose, allowing the possibility of using the facility for church services. Since Gustavo and Henry have begun their services in the little house (below), also in Cofradia, God has blessed with additions and several decisions for Christ. This group will be at the heart of the church meeting in the Day Care building.



For this work to begin, we must agree to fund its' operation. This means, staffing, programming and securing the facility. The budget for this operation will be approximately \$3000 each month to get up and running. This is \$500 above the beginning operational cost due to the necessity of painting, cleaning and doing some repairs.

HONDURAS PROJECT IMPACT INVESTIGATIVE TEAM BRINGS GREAT NEWS ABOUT THE DAY CARE PROJECT AND RECEIVES A CHALLENGE BEYOND THEIR IMAGINATION!!!

Well, looks as though God is at it again... Every time we open the door just a bit, God seems to come thundering through with greater challenges than expected. On Friday, of the mission trip to Honduras, following the return of those on team one, a meeting involving the remaining team members and the president of children's work for northwest Honduras, turned into a challenge beyond our imagination.

The original intent of our meeting was to discuss the proposed Day Care operation in Cofradia. However, following our discussions in which we were allowed to give the Global agenda and intention, the clear discussion of our Kingdom Agenda, and hearing the heart of the president, Global Networks was asked to take a project called "Genesis."

Genesis is a project involving 8 to 10 acres of land and buildings, which was designed to house at least 250 young people who need redirecting in life. (Pictures on the following page) It includes areas of instruction for carpentry skills, sewing skills, computer training areas and many other areas designed to provide usable skills for trainees.

A U.S., nationally known organization, was previously involved in this project, but were dismissed because of serious moral dilemmas and activities.

The project would involve approximately two years of preparatory work before reopening the activity. This being a God-sized undertaking, we need your prayer and support to make it happen. We are quickly reminded of how Gideon, after the downsizing of his army, faced great odds against success from a human standpoint. God, being glorified, brought the victory.

From God's perspective I imagine that; He must see the hurting young people who are in need of this tremendous ministry; He must see those who, even at the reading of this news, will feel the tug of their heart to respond; and He already sees the many teams who will come and make that place shine again for the Glory of God.

I, personally, have committed to return to Honduras on a more permanent basis, to get this accomplished in the next two years. Will you come and help?
